The U-Turn the Wheel program is a community initiative which aims to address the alarming number of young people killed and injured in road crashes.

Young people aged between 17 and 25 years represent 11% of Wingecarribee's population and yet consistently represent over a quarter of all the people killed or injured in crashes on our roads.

The Rotary Club of Moss Vale is a major collaborator in the U-Turn the Wheel program which was created in 1999 as part of their 50th Anniversary Celebrations. Committee members include representatives from local schools, Rotary clubs, Wingecarribee Shire Council, NSW Police Service, Department of Health, parents and community representatives.
